Behind every Registered and Regulated Public Service Translator is the National Register of Public Service Translators (NRPST)

NRPST is managed by the same independent non-commercial organisation that manages the highly respected National Register of Public Service Interpreters (NRPSI).

NRPST is the independent regulator of public service translation in the UK and exists to uphold professional public service translating standards to safeguard the public.

NRPST maintains the register of public service translators and ensures all Registrants have met its rigorous registration requirements by holding the right public service translation qualifications and experience. It also verifies any relevant security clearance.

NRPST manages the Code of Professional Conduct and has a transparent complaints procedure and disciplinary process.

NRPST's online register of public service translators is free to access and search.
